## Welcome to the ADEA Profile Online User's Guide

ADEA *Profile* is the core component of ADEA Knowledge Management System. This database is a compilation of information and knowledge on the 54 countries of Africa. It contains information on more than 1,500 activities carried out since the inception of the Association in 1988. More than 1,200 documents in PDF format are referenced. The database also includes the contact addresses of nearly 1,500 people from more than 500 organizations/agencies/African ministries of education who participate directly or indirectly in ADEA's activities.

The information in ADEA Profile is classified as follows:

- > Basic Information: Objectives of ADEA's programs, lessons learned and names and roles of agencies/organizations associated with ADEA.
- > Activities: Summary description of ADEA's activities, results and lessons learned. They include documents and publications, as well as a list of countries benefitting from or participating in the activities and meetings.
- > **People:** The roles of members and participants involved in ADEA's programs as well as their contact addresses are provided.

**ADEA Profile allows you to search, view and print information** on ADEA's programs, single or multiple activities, beneficiary countries and people involved.

This guide aims to provide you with a quick and easy way to access information and knowledge on all the activities that ADEA has achieved since its inception.

## 1. ADEA Profile search options

You can search the database by **program**, or by **country.** The **Program** option lists all the programs and leads to:

- > **Information:** (details on the program selected)
- Activities: (A chronological list of activities carried out within the program)
- > **People:** An alphabetical list of individuals involved in the program, their status and contact details.

The **Country** option lists all the countries for which there are or have been program activities carried out by ADEA. This leads to selection of information on:

- > Activities
  - or
- > People

### 2.1 Information

For more information on the program select **"Information"** on the right hand side.





### 2.2 Activities

List all the activities for the program in a chronological order. You may obtain more information on the activity by **double-clicking** on the result of the **activities list**.



The "more" option allows you access to a comprehensive printable summary of the activities and information on countries involved. In some cases, it is possible to download the document output of the activity (which appears in red in the activity screen).





For more information on the activities select "more" at the bottom of the page.



#### 2.3 People

You may obtain information on the people involved by selecting from the **"people"** icon on the top right hand side.

### 3. Searching by Country

Select the **Country** or **Region** from the **alphabetical list** on the left hand side. This takes you to all the programs and activities carried out in the country.



### 3.1 Activities

The activities per country appear in a chronological order by year.





To obtain more information on each activity, simply **click** on the **activity description**. A new screen with details of the selected activity will appear at the bottom of the list.



The **« more »** option allows you access to a comprehensive **printable summary** of the activities and information on countries involved. In some cases it is possible to download the document output of the activity (which appears in red in the activity screen).



To select another program, simply return to the lists of programs or countries and continue searching in the same manner.



#### 3.2 People

Profile provides you with the contact information as well as professional profile of the people involved in the activities. This can be obtained for the Countries or the Programs.

When you have selected a **Program** or a **Country**, for more information on the people involved, **click** on their **name**.

### 4.2 Obtaining PDF copies of the Documents

The **More** command button from the **Description** menu bar, also leads to information on the products resulting from the **Activities**. These may include publications and Documents. The publications available for **download** appear **in red** on the screen and you can download them to your computer with a simple click.

### 5. Trouble shooting and other suggestions

#### 5.1 Error message

You may encounter a message "**Please chose a program!**". This occurs when you are still in the "country" zone, which cannot allow access to details on a program. Press "**OK**" and then select a program, or continue your search.



Note: to begin a new search you may choose to use the **"back"** arrow button at the top left hand corner of the program or return to the program or country list to select another program or country

#### 5.2 Using the language option

You may select to browse the database in either English or in French by selecting "En" (for English) or Fr (for French) in the buttons situated at the top right hand corner of the screen. Please note that if you change languages in the middle of a search you will have to re-start the search selection.
